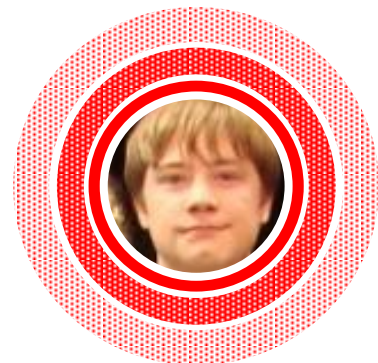

What is Economics?

Economics is a popular A Level subject and involves the study of how individuals, firms and governments make economic decisions and how markets and economic systems operate.

Students of Economics make frequent use of diagrams, data and models to help them examine these areas. This subject is suited to students who have an interest in current affairs and who are comfortable working with graphs and numbers, as well as with writing essays.



Areas studied include demand and supply in markets such as housing, oil, transport and healthcare, the minimum wage, inflation, taxation, exchange rates and the impact of EU expansion and policies.
